Second day of visit of former Malaysian Prime Minister
MAHATHIR BRINGS THE GROUP OF DISTINGUISH BUSINESSMEN
They have shown the interest to invest into air companies, hotel complex, Corridor 5C, energy, bottling of fresh water

I am surprised to see BiH products today. Equally, I am also surprised to hear that these products are exported to EU countries and USA, but on the other side, I have been disappointed because the trade between BiH and Malaysia is almost like nothing, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad the former Prime Minister of Malaysia stated in Sarajevo yesterday.

Presentation of companies

Since last Friday, Mahathir and 11 distinguish Malaysian businessmen are on a three-day visit to our country in order to explore the possibilities to invest in BiH. They have met the representatives of entities governments yesterday and attended the presentation of different BiH products. Eighteen BiH companies have presented themselves to Malaysian businessmen of whom there were 16 from FBiH and 2 from RS. There were Vegafruit, Bosnalijek, Bosnian Handcrafts, BH Telecom, Poljorad, Klas, Ovako, Vispak, Krivaja, and Borac ...

- The expert teams are supposed to arrive in BiH soon and they conduct detailed study on the potentials. I just can add that we are interested on bottling the fresh water, electricity, and construction of airport. In addition, there are some interests to invest into airlines, hotel complex, as well as the possibility to construct Corridor 5C, Tun Dr. Mahathir stated.

Ahmet Hadzipasic Federal Prime Minister sees the possibilities in energy, telecommunications, and tourism sectors. Vahid Heco Federal Minister of Energy, Industry, and Mining stated that the Malaysians have shown its interest in building hydro and thermo power plants. Tan Sri Vincent Tan, one of the richest men of Malaysia addressed the journalists too and stated:

Visit to Medjugorje

- You are close to EU and Middle East and you have great tourist's potentials. We look for a way to invest into hotel complexes. We have already promised to purchase the land in Sarajevo and Visoko and after that, I go to Medjugorje because this is an interesting location too.

Dodik did not come because he was sick

Despite the protocol arrangements, Milorad Dodik RS Prime Minister did not attend yesterday meeting at Hotel Holiday Inn. As Federal Prime Minister Hadzipasic stated, Dodik could not come because he was sick and "it is nothing else on the matter, believe me". Mrs. Jasna Brkic Minister of Economic Relations and Coordination has represented the government of this entity.

Tihic handed over the book "Srebrenica"

Tun Dr. Mahathir has called on Sulejman Tihic, the chairman of BIH Presidency who has presented him the possibilities to invest in BiH.

Tun Dr. Mahathir has stated that his country wishes to invest in naturally rich country especially into the projects, which could create more jobs. At the end of the meeting, Tihic has handed over Tun Dr. Mahathir the book *Srebrenica* by Tarik Samarah.
