Primjer Malezije



Mahatir je za dva dana boravka u BiH, više obradovao njene građane nego svi bh. predstavnici zajedno u posljednjih nekoliko godina

Dolazak bivšeg premijera Malezije Muhameda Mahatira u BiH, i delegacije privrednika koju je predvodio, zasigurno je jedna od najznačajnijih stranih posjeta u posljednje vrijeme.

Muhamed Mahatir je za dva dana boravka u BiH, više obradovao njene građane nego svi bh. predstavnici zajedno u posljednjih nekoliko godina.

Da je Mahatirova posjeta zaista imala „zdrav nijet“, pokazuje činjenica da su s njim u Bosnu doputovali predstavnici pet od petnaest najvećih kompanija Malezije.

Javno su izrazili interes za gradnju koridora 5C, za gradnju aerodroma u Visokom i izgradnju turističkih kapaciteta u BiH, stavljajući tako do znanja bh. građanima da je njihova zemlja interesantna svijetu.

Boravak oca moderne Malezije u BiH za mnoge je bio i prvoklasni tečaj iz predmeta „politički modernizam“, ali i „politički pragmatizam“.

U Maleziji je, naime, ispričao je svojim prijateljima, pročitao priču o piramidama u Visokom i zatražio da posjeti taj lokalitet. Ni trepnuli nisu njegovi saradnici, ali su odmah, nakon dolaska na Visočicu, izjavili da će baš u Visokom kupiti „malo placa“, pa potom u Sarajevu, Međugorju...

Da li su bosanski prvaci koji su se sreli sa Mahatirom u ova dva-tri dana zapamtili išta iz njegove bogate biografije, teško je reći. Ako nisu, za početak, trebali bi znati da je u vrijeme Mahatirove vlasti cijela jedna generacija mladih Malezijaca poslata na školovanje u bijeli svijet, a nakon završetka, vraćena u zemlju da je izgradi onakvom kakva je danas.

I drugo, da je i Malezija zemlja multiratnog nacionalnog spoja, baš kao i BiH i da je razvijenom i modernom postala upravo udruživanjem ekonomskog i političkog interesa zemlje i njenih građana, a ne sitnošćardžijskog interesa malih političkih miševa koji u Bosni i danas vrebaju iza svakog ugla.

MALAYSIAN EXAMPLE

Only for two days of his visit in BiH, Tun Dr. Mahathir has given optimism to BiH citizens more than all their representatives put together in the last few years

Certainly, the visit of Tun Dr. Mahatir Mohamad, former Malaysian Prime Minister to BiH who led the business delegation on this occasion is one of the most important foreign visits lately.

Only for two days of his visit in BiH, Tun Dr. Mahathir has given optimism to BiH citizens more than all their representatives put together in last few years.

Obviously, Tun Mahathir's visit had a "healthy nijet (intention)" since he brought the representatives of five of the fifteen largest companies of Malaysia.

They have publicly stressed the interest on construction of Corridor 5C, Visoko airport and tourists capacities in BiH and proved to BiH citizens that this country can attract investors like the rest of the world.

Many could observe the visit of the Father of Modern Malaysia to BiH as an extraordinary course both on political modernism and on political pragmatism.

Namely, he told his friends in Malaysia that when he read the story on the Visoko pyramids, he immediately requested to visit this site. His associates did not wait at all to organise the visit and upon his arrival to Visoko, some of them have stated that they would buy "some small pieces of land" exactly there as well as in Sarajevo and Medjugorje.

It is hard to say if in these few days Bosnian political leaders who met Tun Mahathir have remembered anything of his rich biography. However, if they were not, for the very beginning they should know that during Tun Mahathir's premiership, the whole generation of young Malaysians have been schooled abroad and after that returned to country to build its institutions such it is now.

Secondly, they should know that Malaysia is a country of multiracial national unity such as Bosnia itself and its contemporary development is the result of harmonising the economic and political interests of the country, and the collective interests of its citizens unlike the cheap interest of small political mousses in BiH who waited for an opportunity at every corner.
