Hadžipašić: Najizvjesnija su ulaganja u turizam

Premijer očekuje konkretne rezultate u zajedničkim ulaganjima i plasmanu robe domaćih kompanija

The impressions on the visit of high Malaysian delegation
HADZIPASIC: THE MOST CERTAIN THE INVESTMENTS INTO TOURISM
Prime Minister expects the concrete results on common investments and marketing
the goods of home companies

High delegation of Malaysia led by Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad the former Prime Minister after its three-day visit to BiH left this country with a positive impression that for the first time the institutions of this country have presented the possibilities and direction of common interests on investments.

Ahmet Hadzipasic Federal Prime Minister in his assessment as the host of Malaysian businessmen after meeting Tun Dr. Mahathir last time, believes that Government of FBiH has succeeded to present the business opportunities and not the story of emotions and friendship.

Business story

Previously, everyone had their own story based on their connectivity with Malaysian top politicians and business leaders. We had the intention to show that the institutions, governments, ministries, and not individuals are the partners and this was welcomed by the Malaysian delegation, Hadzipasic said.

He expects the various projects related to energy, communications, tourism and food industries to be given grater focus through direct contacts with the Malaysian investors in the next few months. He reveals to us that currently Malaysia shows interest in BiH tourism.

Offers from whole BiH

They have shown the special interest on Medjugorje, Visoko, Sarajevo, Una, winter centres, and spas. However, first they should look at their interests, safety of their capital and the return of investments. They are interested to build new tourist capacities and in a sense we should clear the status of ownership and purchase the land, the Prime Minister stressed.

He adds that in organising this visit program, they had on their mind the whole territory of BIH with no entity division. They have looked at the possibility of accepting investing in local companies and increasing the production for marketing of its goods in Malaysia.

Energy sector and Corridor 5C

In relation to other investment projects which Malaysia shows interests, these includes building of new hydro and thermo power plants, modernisation of current ones and reconstruction of mines. On Corridor 5C construction, which is a state project, the guests have accepted the position of the Federal Government and we told them that it should be institutionally resolved, strengthened, concretised, and proven by the supporting data in order to make decision on partnership with foreign investors, Hadzipasic ends.
