

Fu: DAP has no basis to criticise Govt

MALACCA: The DAP is an opportunist party which is out to spoil the image of Barisan Nasional by preying on voter sentiments, said MCA publicity bureau chief Datuk Fu Ah Kiow.

He said the DAP did not have any basis to criticise the Government.

"I believe the voters understand the situation and have the wisdom to make the right choice in the (Machap) by-election," said Fu during a visit to Machap Baru.

Fu said he was confident that the voters in Machap would support the Barisan candidate and that MCA members would work hard to ensure that the coalition won with an even bigger majority.

"The opposition will use all kinds of tactics to win over the voters and bring up issues which the locals might not be satisfied about.

"From the Batu Talam by-election

two months ago, we can already see how inconsistent the opposition is," he said.

He pointed out that during the Batu Talam by-election, the opposition had said it would boycott the Election Commission (EC) and the election but now it wanted to contest in Machap.

"The EC is still the same but it is the DAP which has changed," he added.

In Putrajaya, MCA Youth chief Datuk Liow Tiong Lai said he was willing to debate with DAP Youth but not on the topic of national development.

"Everybody knows about the extent of DAP's contribution to national development so there is no need to debate it," he said.

DAP Youth chief Nga Kor Ming had challenged MCA Youth to a debate in the run-up to the Machap by-election.
