

# PM's deadline for new delivery system

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi wants all state leaders and ministers to ensure that the government machinery is prepared to implement the new government delivery system in 13 days.

The prime minister said he gave the instruction at the National Physical Planning Committee meeting attended by all menteris besar, chief ministers and several ministers in Putrajaya on Wednesday.

"I hope the ministers will follow up on this matter. This is important as we only have 13 days to go. We want them to monitor the state of preparedness to carry out the new government delivery system.

"We want them to call up department heads to make sure that everything is in place for the implementation," he said when addressing Kuala Lumpur City Hall senior officials during a one-day tour of the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur yesterday.

Abdullah said that it was necessary to ensure there were no glitches that could frustrate the

people who harboured high hopes following the government's announcement two months ago that

the delivery system would be improved.

Abdullah reminded City Hall personnel on the importance of their participation in ensuring a successful implementation of the government delivery system to meet the people's aspirations.

"Suggestions from the people should be looked into and implemented (whenever suitable). We must make decisions," he said, urging them to deliver friendly service.

Abdullah also said that all projects that had received approval must be carried out without delay.

"The allocation is there so don't wait any longer. And when the projects are being carried out, monitor them so that they're completed on schedule."

The prime minister said that close monitoring would enable problems to be tackled quickly towards an effective implementation of projects. — Bernama
