## Chance for youths to understand his legacy

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Youths are invited to attend a seminar on the contributions of former prime minister Tun Abdul Razak.

Umno Youth deputy chief Khairy Jamaluddin said it would be an excellent opportunity for the young to get to know Razak's policies and achievements.

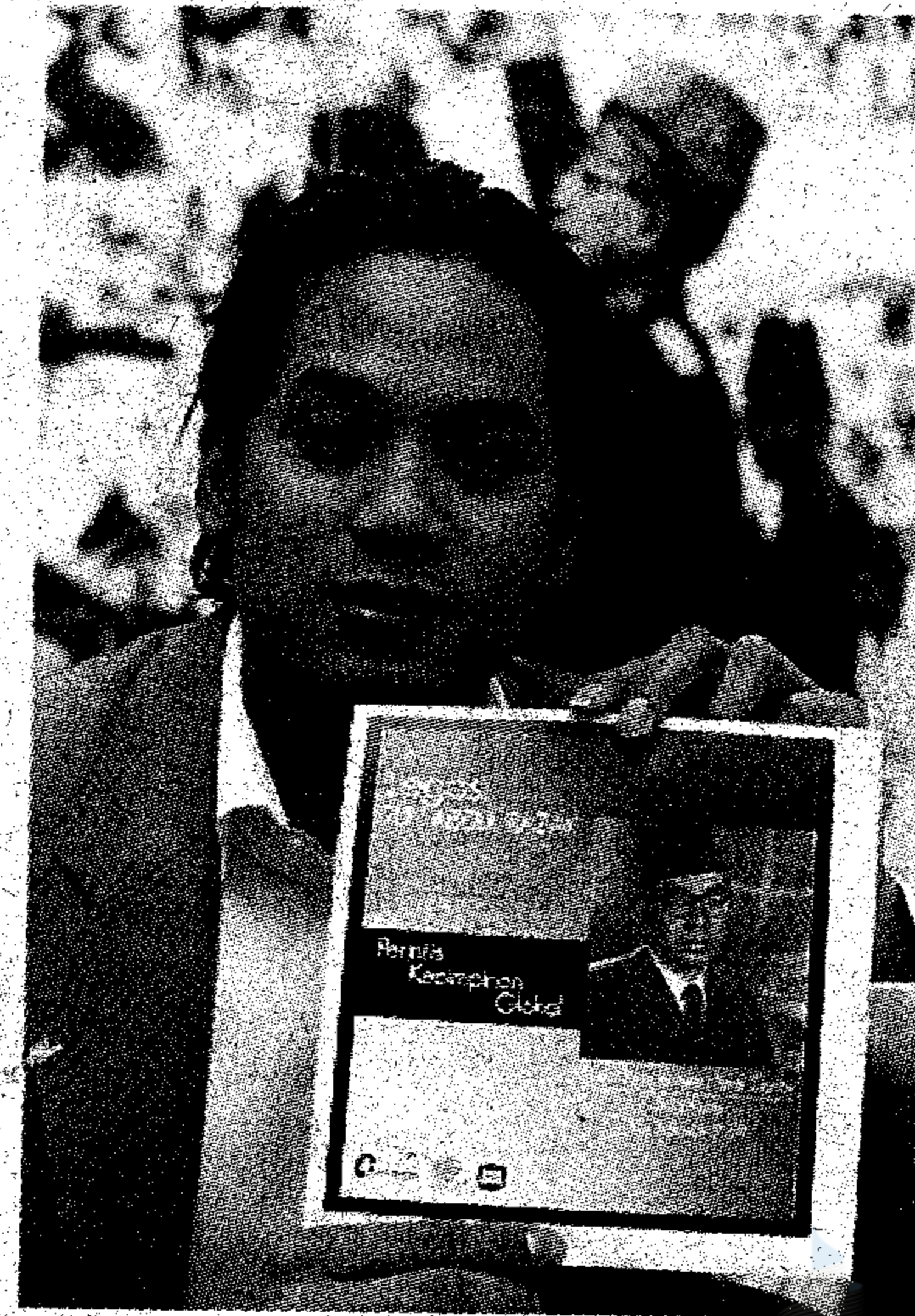
