

Pas wants to work with DAP

KOTA BARU: Pas is leaving the door open to DAP and other opposition parties to work together in the general election.

Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat said the party was open to co-operating with the DAP.

He said there was no reason for the DAP not to work with Pas as the party had a good record ruling Kelantan.

"We are open to everybody,

including the DAP. It was the DAP which rejected us. I cannot understand why. We have not done anything wrong."

Nik Aziz was speaking after receiving a courtesy call from Parti Keadilan Rakyat adviser Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim at his office here yesterday.

Anwar said opposition parties worked together well with no issues dividing them.

"Basically, our views on major issues do not differ much. It is the media which is sensationalising everything."

He said there might be some

differences at the grassroots level but this was expected.

"We might not share the same stage or have one manifesto for all parties but the opposition is united. We will appoint a single opposition candidate for each seat we contest against the Barisan Nasional in the election."

Anwar is confident that Pas will continue to rule Kelantan.

"Kelantan Umno does not have a personality with a strong character who is experienced enough to compete with Pas leaders."
