

Dr Mahathir admitted to ICU for fatigue

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LANGKAWI: Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad was admitted to the intensive care unit of the Langkawi Hospital at 4.45pm yesterday after complaining of fatigue in his hotel room.

Kedah Health director Dr Hasnah Ismail said the former prime minister was in stable condition and resting in the hospital.

Dr Mahathir and his wife Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, arrived here at 11am yesterday for a two-day private visit.

His press officer, Sufi Yusni Yusof, said Dr Mahathir had complained of exhaustion.

He was taken to the hospital by car by his personal physician, Dr Nasir Muda.

"If his condition improves, we may transfer him to the National Heart Institute (IJN) in Kuala Lumpur," said Dr Mahathir's son, Datuk Mukhriz, at the hospital yesterday.
