KUALA LUMPUR: Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad has been transferred to the Bunga Raya Ward from the Cardiac Care Unit of the National Heart Institute (IJN).

IJN Corporate Communications Department said in a statement that doctors were satisfied with the former prime minister's positive response to treatment and medication.

It said Dr Mahathir would be warded at IJN to allow doctors to monitor his condition and start cardiac rehabilitation.

Dr Mahathir was transferred to IJN from Langkawi Hospital where he was warded after complaining of breathing difficulties.

Doctors at IJN had diagnosed it as caused by lung congestion associated with a heart attack. —
