

Public Bank sets up 2-year research programme

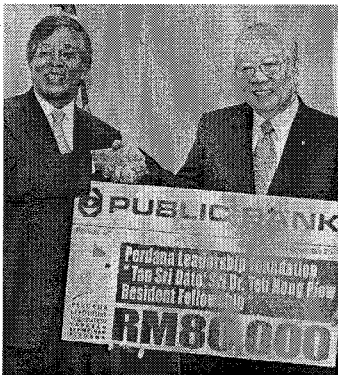
KUALA LUMPUR: Public Bank Bhd has set up the Tan Sri Datuk Seri Dr Teh Hong Piow Resident Fellowship Programme that would allow scholars to pursue research at the Perdana Leadership Foundation (PLF).

In a statement yesterday, it said the research findings under the two-year programme would be made available for publication by the PLF.
