Abdullah: We have the experience in developing the country

PUTRAJAYA: The Barisan Nasional's good track record in developing the country and its experience over the years in governing the country should be the basis for the people to continue supporting the coalition in the general election.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi said Barisan had fulfilled its promises to the people and had put in place many development programmes.
