NUBE: Dr M being vindictive

PETALING JAYA: The National Union of Bank Employees (NUBE) had hit out at former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad for "being vindictive" against Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.

Its secretary-general J. Solomon said NUBE believed the current Prime Minister is the best leader to unite and build Malaysia and would make the right decision for the nation's economic progress.

"The current situation in the country did not suddenly arise over the last four to five years.

"It is years and years of pent-up frustration across the nation (not confined to any specif-

ic ethnic group) that has grown since Dr Mahathir's era," said Solomon in a statement.

He added that the results of the general election were a true reflection of the people's power.

"We appeal to Pak Lah to "let sour grapes whine in their frustration" and while he works with the people's elected representatives in the various states to build this nation for all Malaysians", he said.

Solomon also advised first-time *wakil rakyat* to focus on fulfilling their promise to the people instead of making premature demands against Abdullah.
