Kg Baru bazaar draws Dr M, Najib

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak visited the Kampung Baru Ramadan bazaar with his family yesterday to buy his favourite delicacies for the breaking of fast on the first day of Ramadan.

He spent close to an hour walking around the bazaar, meeting with people. He also bought chicken rice and rojak.

"I love to eat. During fasting month, everything looks good," he said when asked what his favourite dish was.

Najib and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, met former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad at the bazaar.

"He noticed that I was carrying a lot of cash in my hand and asked me what I bought," Najib said, drawing laughter.

Two of Najib's children, Mohd Norashman and Nooryana Najwa, as well as Federal Territories Minister Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin joined the prime minister on his walkabout.

Earlier, Najib had distributed *bubur lambuk* to the residents in the area.

Yesterday, about 100 pots of *bubur lambuk* were prepared, sponsored by the Tourism Ministry.
