People must play their part, says Muhyiddin

KUALA LUMPUR: The involvement and support of the people is important to ensure the success of the six National Key Result Areas (NKRAs), said Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin yesterday. -

"The involvement and support from the people would help the government in achieving the objectives underlined in the NKRAs.

"The government has displayed its commitment by creating labs, to conduct detailed research on the feedback gathered from the people regarding their aspirations, and the focus that must be given by the government to overcome the problems.

"The people must feel that they

are also part of this to ensure its success," Muhyiddin said after the launching of the Government Transformation Programme (GTP) Roadmap by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak at Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre here.

Muhyiddin, who is also the Education Minister, said that his ministry would give full commitment to ensure the four sub-sections under the NKRA for education are implemented.

He said as for this year, several aspects have been identified like increasing the number of schools and classes for pre-schools, increasing the number of trained teachers and announcing the 20 high-performance schools.
