Ahirudin was assisted by a panel of judges, including Wan Abdillah Edruce, Harmandar Singh, Azmi Abdul Rahman and Dahlia Daphne Iking.

MSMF chairman Datuk Seri Azman Ujang said the objective of the contest was to give the public a chance to "interact" with the country's leader.

"It also gave them the opportunity to showcase their creativity."

He said the submissions, even the ones that did not win, would be presented to the prime minister during the prize-giving ceremony. Azman said the date would be announced later.
