**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Malay College Old Boys' Association of Malaysia (MCOBA) has added another milestone to the long and illustrious history of the school.

It is now embarking on a journey to compile all documentations, correspondence, photographs and videos pertaining to the school for its MCOBA Archives.

The MCOBA Archives was launched yesterday by the Raja Muda of Perak Raja Dr Nazrin Shah at Bangunan MCOBA.

Present was MCOBA president Tan Sri Megat Najmuddin Megat Khas.

The archives committee, headed by Bahari Atan, who studied at the school from 1952 to 1960, is appealing to Old Boys and their families to contribute artefacts to its archives.

Prior to this, MCOBA stored copies of its artefacts on a digital software system and hosted much of its history on its website, [www.mcoba.org](http://www.mcoba.org), with materials from the National Archives.
