# Anwar's car damaged in attack

**PETALING JAYA:** Opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's car was damaged while a Johor Keadilan Youth leader was injured after being attacked by youths on motorcycles following a speech at the local PKR office in Semberong, near Kluang on Sunday evening.

"The ruffians were throwing sticks, stones, firecrackers and rotten eggs. One of the rocks damaged the windshield of Anwar's car.

"Johor Keadilan Youth leader Mohd Nazri Ismail Nazri was injured when he tried to stop a group from approaching Anwar," PKR secretary general Saifuddin Nasution said yesterday.

The incident happened near Keadilan office

on Jalan Mersing, where Anwar had earlier given a speech, and a police report was lodged at the Kluang police station at 3am yesterday.

"There were no less than 20 police officers at the event, but they did nothing to stop the ruffians. They were making noises and throwing firecrackers throughout the event," Saifuddin told reporters.

Kluang police chief ACP Abd Majid Mohd Ali said police have begun their probe into the incident. He said police have recorded a statement from the complainant but have yet to make any arrest.

On claims that policemen on duty at the scene had done nothing and merely watched the attack, he said: "We are investigating the claims. We will call up witnesses to assist in the case but let us investigate first."
