1 Malaysia libraries to be set: u p i n K L

KUALA LUMPUR: 1 Malaysia Libraries are set to be built this year at Lembah Pantai, Titiwangsa and Wangsa Maju.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, in announcing this during his meet-the-people session in Lembah Pantai yesterday, said: "In this ICT age, it is not just the young people who want to jump onto the bandwagon, but the old too."

Najib also announced that a Permata kindergarten would be set up in the Kerinchi area.

Meanwhile, at a separate function, he announced an action committee will be formed to create the 1 Malaysia One-Stop Registry of Deceased's Assets and Liabilities.

Najib said the centre will be spearheaded by AmanahRaya.

"With the centre, all processes can be executed easily will lessen the suffering of the inheritors who lost their loved ones," he said in his speech at the launch of the 90th Anniversary of AmanahRaya and AmanahRaya Foundation here yesterday.

The speech was read by Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Tan Sri Nor Mohamed Yakcop.

He also announced the appointment of four trustees.

They are the foundation chairman Datuk Dusuki Ahmad, Tan Sri Arshad Ayub, Datin Aminah Pit Ab Ramah and AmanahRaya Group managing director Datuk Ahmad Rodzi Pawanteh.
