'Karpal rejects hudud because he's non-believer'

IN the clearest sign yet that Pas is unrelenting on its hudud stand, Pas Youth chief Nasrudin Hassan Tantawi tweeted last night that those who rejected Allah's laws would be considered *kufur* (non-believer).

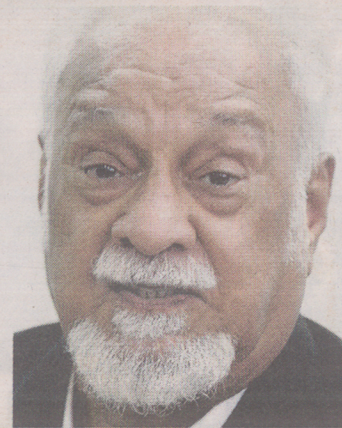
Karpal has always been vocal about his objection to the implementation of hudud in Malaysia.
