# Anwar ready to cooperate if there's probe over RM3bil stash

DATUK Seri Anwar Ibrahim will cooperate if investigations are carried out on the alleged RM3bil that he had purportedly stashed in 20 master accounts.

The Opposition Leader said he would not stop authorities from carrying out their investigations.

"If there is other evidence presented, I have no problems and will cooperate.

"But there should be an open investigation, Investigate accounts belonging to my family and me and also the accounts belonging to the Prime Minister, the Deputy Prime

Minister and their families," he said when debating the Supplementary Supply Bill.

'Former Bank Negara assistant governor Datuk Abdul Murad Khalid recently said he was prepared to cooperate with the authorities over allegations that Anwar had several

master accounts totalling RM3bil.

In his statement, Abdul Murad confirmed that he had made a statutory declaration in 1999 over the handling of the accounts.

Many parties had since called for Anwar to explain the allegation and for the authorities to investigate.

Anwar said he had given full cooperation to the then Anti-Corruption Agency which had investigated his accounts when he was in prison,

He claimed that the investigation chief, after leaving the service, had filed an affidavit to say that he had found no basis in the allegations,
