# Dr M: We're on track for Vision 2020

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad believes the country is on the right track to achieving Vision 2020.

He expressed confidence that Barisan Nasional would get a two-thirds majority in the general election to form a strong government.

Dr Mahathir added he was glad that Vision 2020 remained a major subject among leaders, despite a different policy being introduced when his successor had taken over office.

"It looks like they are working hard towards achieving Vision 2020 and there are indicators that we are on the right track.

"They may have different approaches to it but I believe we will realise the vision as soon as we enter 2020," he said at Putra World Trade Centre here.

Dr Mahathir said a weak government would be subject to attacks by detractors. "Therefore, a two-thirds majority needs to be given to this government so that it can be more firm and decisive."

Earlier, Dr Mahathir had launched his book, *Blogging to Unblock Book 2: A Citizen's Rights*, a sequel to *Blogging to Unblock*, first published in 2008.

The second book is a compilation of his writings from September 2008 to last year. The articles were selected based on the highest number of comments on his blog, chedet.com
