NGO lodges report against Dr M

GEORGE TOWN: A non-governmental organisation yesterday lodged a report against former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, with regard to statements in his blog on 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB) and the murder of Mongolian model, Altantuya Shaariibuu.

The NGO, which declared itself to be Pakatan-friendly, claimed the remarks had incited the public.

Penang Solidariti Anak Muda Malaysia co-

ordinator Mohd Aidil Fitri Ibrahim said Dr Mahathir had no right to utter such remarks and urged the police to investigate the matter.

“The former prime minister should be called in by police to have his statement recorded.

“That he is a man of influence does not give him the right to utter whatever remarks he likes,” Aidil Fitri said after lodging the report at the Bayan Baru police station yesterday.
