> Najib says Cabinet members must work as one team

PUTRAJAYA: Cabinet members have been urged to trust one another in working for the betterment of the people.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak, who recently axed his deputy Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin in a massive Cabinet reshuffle, said those in the administration must not lose focus in ensuring the country's transformation policy is fulfilled.

"My friends and I in the new Cabinet are determined to do our best as a cohesive team to execute the government's policy to fulfil all the people's aspirations," he said.

"Let us work together as one team that helps and trusts each other," he said during a Prime Minister's Office (PMO) Hari Raya Aidilfitri reception at Putrajaya International Convention Centre here yesterday.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Ali Hamsa and several other ministers.

Najib added that it is expected of the government to make changes from time to time to serve the people better.

"This is why I expect the government to not only implement changes but also show improvement in terms of its achievements and actions," he said.

"This is something that should be embedded in our mind every time. Let tomorrow be better than today," he added.

Najib said good cooperation among all members of the administration would ensure the success of the country's vision and progress.

He also gave "duit raya" to 15 orphan children while the Federal Territory Islamic Religious Council donated RM15,000 to welfare homes.
