RM10m for mosque repairs

PUTRAJAYA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak yesterday received contributions amounting to RM10 million for the Tabung Ihsan Pemulihan Masjid Banjir Kelantan to restore mosques and surau damaged by the December floods in the east coast state.

The ceremony was held at the Perdana Putra building here with several cabinet ministers, including Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Shahidan Kassim and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa

The cheques for the contributions were handed over to the prime minister by representatives of the donors, which included Bank Islam Malaysia, Bank Rakyat, Felcra Bhd and Special Committee to Promote Understanding and Harmony Among Religious Adherents under the National Unity and Integration Department.
