Fruitful talks with Najib, says Kelantan MB

POSITIVE: Meeting on road project, migration of water management

THE meeting between Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Ahmad Yakob and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak on Monday was fruitful, Ahmad said yesterday. Ahmad said the meeting served as a bilateral discussion between the state government and Federal Government on several issues of interest to the Kelantan people.

He said the discussion also touched on the "Central Spine Road", a 417km construction project located on the border of Pahang and Negri Sembilan, as well as the issue of the migration on water management to the federal body.

"The courtesy call (to the prime minister) is part of my duty, as spelt out in the annual calendar to convey the claims and fulfil the needs of the Kelantan people.

"Please pray to Allah to ease my efforts and the leadership of the state government in the service of the people," Ahmad said in a Facebook post.

Deputy Menteri Besar Datuk Mohd Amar Nik Abdullah said the meeting of the two leaders showed positive development, particularly on the issue of the migration of water management.

"The two leaders also talked about the post-flood reconstruction programme. We have asked for the implementation to be sped up," he said.

Najib, via his Twitter and Facebook ac-

counts on Monday, said he and the menteri besar had discussed several issues relating to the welfare of the Kelantan people when Ahmad paid a visit to his office in Putrajaya.
