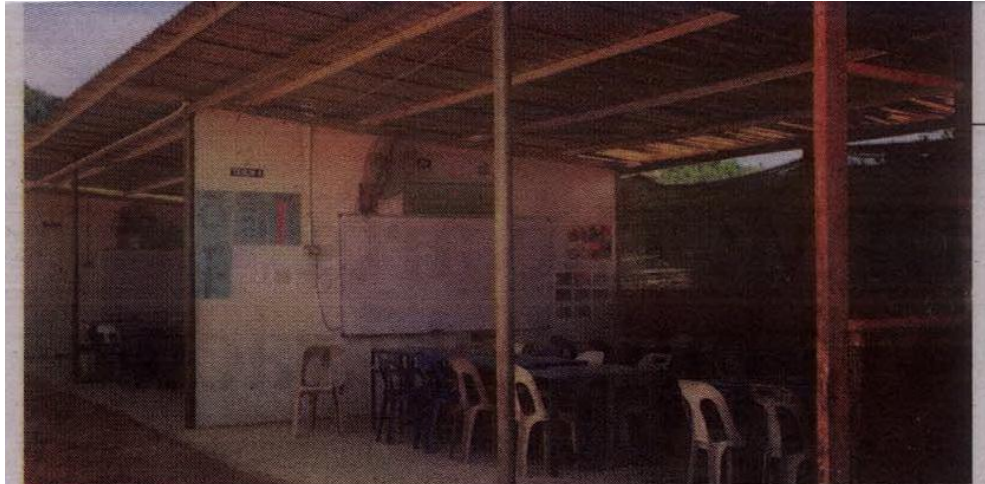

PM: Immediate action over 'school with no wall'

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak wants immediate action to resolve the woes faced by SK Penimbawan in Tuaran, Sabah, where students are studying under makeshift tents.

Deemed the "school with no wall" on Twitter, the pictures caught the attention of Najib after it was highlighted to him by user @Saroki 19.

On his Twitter account, Najib said "TS KSN @alihamsa55 siasat & ambil tindakan utk bantu jika benar. Ini tdk patut berlaku" (Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Dr Ali Hamsa please investigate and take action if this is true. This should not have happened #schoolwithnowall).

SK Penimbawan was one of the schools that was destroyed in a fire along with SK Pekan Kiulu, SK Gadong, SK Simpangan and SK Tampasak in Sabah.

Sabah Education Department director Datuk Jame Alip said it would be receiving RM10 million to repair the schools.

News about the schools have made waves among Twitter users as they expressed disbelief over the lack of action by the state education department as well as other relevant authorities.

Najib's immediate response has won the praise of social media users.
