# PM to meet Jokowi

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak is on a two-day working visit to Indonesia beginning today.

According to a statement from the Foreign Affairs Ministry, Najib is scheduled to hold bilateral talks with President Joko Widodo to strengthen bilateral cooperation in the palm oil industry.

“This visit will provide the opportunity to explore and enhance cooperation towards a sustainable palm oil industry. Both leaders will

also discuss issues pertaining to environmental cooperation,” it said, adding the visit was a follow-up to earlier meetings.

The prime minister will be accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister Datuk Douglas Uggah Embas, Natural Resources and Environment Minister Datuk Seri Dr Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar and Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister’s Department Datuk Razali Ibrahim.
