KUALA LUMPUR: Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's constant criticism of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak seems excessive and unnecessary, Sungai Besar Umno division chief Datuk JamalMd Yunus said.

Jamal said Dr Mahathir's call for Najib to step down was unfair as the prime minister was elected through a democratic system.
