Najib: I don't feel lonely at all

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister uatuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said he does not feel lonely, in an apparent response to Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's remark.

Najib said there had been some talk lately in Malaysia about how lonely it could be in telling the truth.

"Well, I can tell you that I don't feel lonely standing here in front of you all today!

"And when so many respected international bodies, individuals and institutions have confirmed their belief in Malaysia's success, and have honoured us by rating us so highly, I don't feel lonely at all - in fact, I feel I am in very good company!

"And I am equally confident that, given the well-known stability and growth of Malaysia under this government, I will be able to look

forward to ~~the~~ ^leasure of your company both next year and for years to come," he said, while delivering the keynote address at Invest Malaysia 2015.

Dr Mahathir had recently written in his blog chedet.cc about feeling alone in his pursuit for answers to debts accumulated by Malaysia Development Berhad (IMDB) and the murder of Mongolian model Altantuya Shaariibuu.

The former prime minister's posting attracted online support from celebrities, including Datuk Siti Nurhaliza Taruddin and Rozita Che Wan.

Last Sunday, Najib's brother, CIMB group chairman Datuk Seri Nazir Razak posted a picture of Michael Jackson with the words "You are not alone" on his Instagram account.
