BREAK TIME: Umno president mingles with reporters covering assembly

PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak yesterday briefly stepped away from the serious business of politics to mingle with the hordes of journalists at the temporary media centre in the Putra World Trade Centre here.

Najib, who is also Umno president, had a full schedule on the second day of the party's annual general assembly at PWTC.

During the lunch break, he visited the booths of various media organisations to meet reporters covering the assembly.

At The New Straits Times Press Bhd booth, Najib was greeted by Media Prima Bhd group chairman Datuk Seri F D Iskandar, group managing director Datuk Seri Amrin Awaluddin, NSTP chief executive officer Datuk Mohammad Azlan Abdullah, NSTP group managing editor Datuk Abdul Ja'Ul Hamid and NST group editor Mustapha Kamil.

Iskandar presented a photo album consisting of 27 best pictures taken at the recent Asean Summit and Related Summits which Najib hosted. Earlier, he joined the Friday prayers' congregation at Surau Ar-Rahman in PWTC.
