# 'Made in Malaysia products just as good, if not better'

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak hopes more Malaysians will support and buy locally-made products to help sustain the nation's economic

He said buying products made in Malaysia would reduce the flow of money overseas and boost development of local industries.
