PM calls for safety audit

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak has called for an audit to be carried out following two incidents involving the light rail transit (LRT) yesterday to ensure the safety of passengers.

Commenting on the incidents that occurred near Setiawangsa and Universiti LRT stations yesterday, he said he was thankful that no passengers were hurt.

"Syukur tiada cedera dlm kejadian LRT di Setiawangsa & Universiti. Audit wajar dilakukan agar keselamatan penumpang diuta-

makan. (I am thankful that no one was injured in the LRT incidents in Setiawangsa and Universiti. Audit should be carried out as safety of passengers comes first) he tweeted.

Yesterday, two LRT coaches were engulfed in smoke when brake fluid leaked and hit the hot iron tracks.

The train operators evacuated passengers and transferred them to another train.

No injuries were reported in the incidents.
