"Happy Ramadan Ai-Mubarak to all Muslims. May your fast be accepted by Allah," he tweeted.

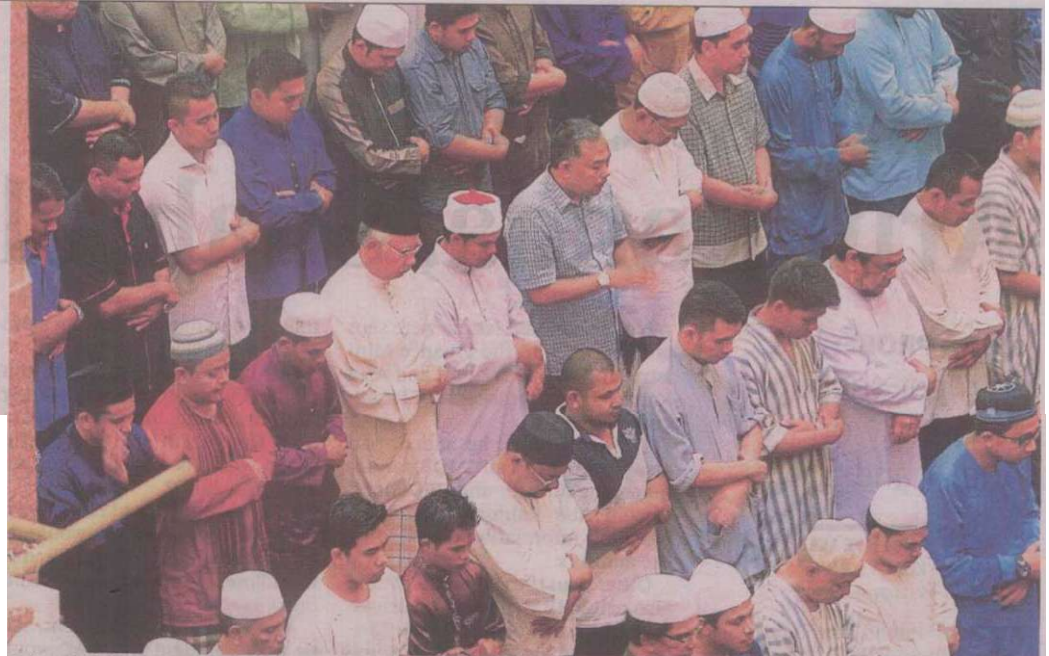
