KUALA LUMPUR: Veteran DAP leader Lim Kit Siang is claiming that more people are likely to face action over the Malaysia Development Bhd (IMDB) issue.

He alleged that former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad was the group's leader. The Geiang Patah member of parliament also alleged that 21 people had been identified as conspirators against parliamentary democracy and it was likely that action would be taken against them.

They include The Edge Communications Sdn Bhd executive chairman Dr Tong Kooi Ong, The Edge Communications Sdn Bhd group chief ex-

ecutive officer and publisher Ho Kay Tat, British investigative journalist and editor-in-chief of Sarawak Report Clare Rewcastle Brown and Petaling Jaya Utara MP Tony Pua.

Lim alleged that his six-month suspension from Dewan Rakyat was also related to the IMDB issue.

"I am only the latest victim of the IMDB monster and more victims, including former prime minister Tun Mahathir, will be the casualties unless the IMDB monster can be stopped

in its tracks he said on Friday.

Lim was suspended for questioning the integrity of Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia.
