Najib: Mustapa has mandate to negotiate TPPA

PETALING JAYA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak said in his Facebook that he has given the mandate to International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed to negotiate the terms of the Trans-Pacific Partnership

Agreement (TPPA).
Meanwhile, Mustapa announced that 12 countries - Malaysia, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Peru, Singapore, the US and Vietnam - have reached an agreement in TPPA negotiations in the US.

said in a month's time, the TPPA's contents with the cost-benefit analysis will be prepared and made public.
"Both documents will be presented to Parliament in two months' time and debated on, whether to agree or not with the TPPA."
