# 'Pas won't join Dr M to oust PM'

## 'MATURE POLITICS':

Pas sec-gen says party has its own approach and movement

**P**AS will not be taking part in the plan to demand the removal of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

In a statement yesterday, Pas secretary-general Datuk Takiyuddin Hassan said although the party appreciated the invite from Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, he said the party had its own approach and movement.

"We (Pas) have our own approach and movement through the Third Political Block towards changing the country's leadership, through democratic and constitutional channels.

"Looking at the situation, we will suggest to the Conference of Rulers that a royal commission be established to conduct a thorough investigation into issues surrounding 1Malaysia Development Bhd, the RM2.6 billion donation, the SRC International and other issues, as decreed by the recent Conference of Rulers," Takiyuddin said.

He said Pas was consistent in its "mature politics" approach as a formula for change in the country's government system.

He added that Pas urged that Parliament be dissolved soon to allow for elections, giving back the mandate to the people to change the country's leadership.

"Pas calls upon everyone to be with the party and the Third Po-

litical Block as an alternative to build a better Malaysia."

Meanwhile, Pakatan Harapan chief secretary Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah said the opposition pact would not hold a joint press conference with Dr Mahathir today.

Speaking to reporters at PKR's headquarters yesterday, Saifuddin said opposition leaders, should they at-

tend the press conference, would only do so in their personal capacity.

He was clarifying an earlier statement by PKR vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar that Pakatan Harapan would host the conference with Dr Mahathir.

"I wasn't there when she was asked (whether Pakatan Harapan would hold a

joint press conference with Dr Mahathir), but she told us that her statement was taken out of context.

"She was trying to explain that, as far as she knew, there will be a meeting tomorrow (today) with Dr Mahathir.

"She knows some individuals from Pakatan Harapan will join the meeting.

"All this is being done by our friends in Pakatan Harapan in their own personal capacity."
