Wan Azizah snubs Dr M's declaration

NO SUPPORT: PKR leader declines to meet ex-PM over bid to topple Najib

PKR president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail has snubbed the so-called "Mahathir-Kit Siang" declaration, saying she will not support it.

"At the moment, I don't need to," said Dr Wan Azizah, whose husband Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim was sacked as deputy prime minister by

the movement, which aimed to topple Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

This is the second blow to the movement started by Dr Mahathir after Umno veteran Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah had rebuked it.

Dr Mahathir had announced that Tengku Razaleigh had been on board but the latter had later said that that he did not agree with toppling the prime minister through unconstitutional ways.

The Gua Musang member of parliament had also denied his involvement in a statutory declaration calling for him to be the next prime minister.
