Pas: Ex-MB wants to join Dr M's party

KUALA TERENGGANU: Pas believes that Kijal assemblyman Datuk Seri Ahmad Said has no intention of joining the party, but will join the new party to be set up by former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Terengganu Pas commissioner Satiful Bahari Mamat said Ahmad, who is seen as a close associate of Dr Mahathir, was getting more daring in criticising the state administration under Menteri Besar Ahmad Razif Abdul Rahman.

“He doesn’t fear any disciplinary action. In fact, he is waiting for it to happen. When he said he wanted to leave Umno and join Pas, I knew there was no way he was joining us. He is merely using Pas as a smoke-screen to pursue a bigger ambition.

“One of the telltale signs is that he was appointed as the state’s president of Perkasa, a non-governmental organisation affiliated with Dr Mahathir. It is obvious that his ultimate motive is to overthrow Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.”
