Dr M to be probed over blog post

REPORTS LODGED: Cops will arrest him if there is an offence, says IGP

TUN Dr Mahathir Mohamad will be investigated by police over a blog post which has been deemed defamatory.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar said reports were lodged over the matter a few

days ago, but did not reveal which blog post by the former prime minister was being investigated.

"We will begin with our investigation based on the reports made.

"If there is any offence, we will arrest," he said after witnessing a handing over of duties ceremony between outgoing Penang police chief Datuk Seri Abdul Rahim

Hanafi and his successor Datuk Abdul Ghafar Rajab.

Asked who had lodged the reports against Dr Mahathir, Khalid would only say: "Members of the public."

Recently, Umno information chief Tan Sri Annuar Musa was reported as saying that Dr Mahathir's post entitled "AG to AG" was seditious.

Following his statement, Khalid urged parties who had found the article seditious to lodge a police report if they felt offended by it.
