# 'Umno not pushing for Dr M's arrest'

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said Umno was not out to get Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad arrested over his hard-hitting blog post against the current leadership.

The deputy prime minister said the matter did not involve Umno.

"On that matter, it has nothing to do with Umno. Please (bring it up with) the inspector-general of police," said Zahid, who is also Umno vice-president.

He said this when asked to comment on a post on Dr Mahathir's blog, in which the former premier said he believed Umno wanted him arrested.

Dr Mahathir wrote that this was clear when Umno's new information chief, Tan Sri Annuar Musa, suggested that his constant criticisms of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak and Attorney-General Tan Sri Apandi Ali was an attempt to get him (Dr Mahathir) arrested.
