NSTP holds Tun Razak photo exhibition

KUALA LUMPUR: The New Straits Times Press (NSTP) will feature a photo exhibition titled "Legacy of Leadership — Special Commemorative Seminar on Tun Abdul Razak (Prime Minister of Malaysia 1970-1976)" at The Royale Chulan Hotel Kuala Lumpur today.

The exhibition will feature 60 pictures of Tun Abdul Razak Hussein, including those taken when he was appointed as the second prime minister by Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tu-

anku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah.

Tun Razak's son, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, also received his letter of appointment from the same ruler.

NSTP resource centre manager Ramlan Ramli said the exhibition would feature 20 front-page articles that had appeared in the *New Straits Times* and *Berita Harian*.

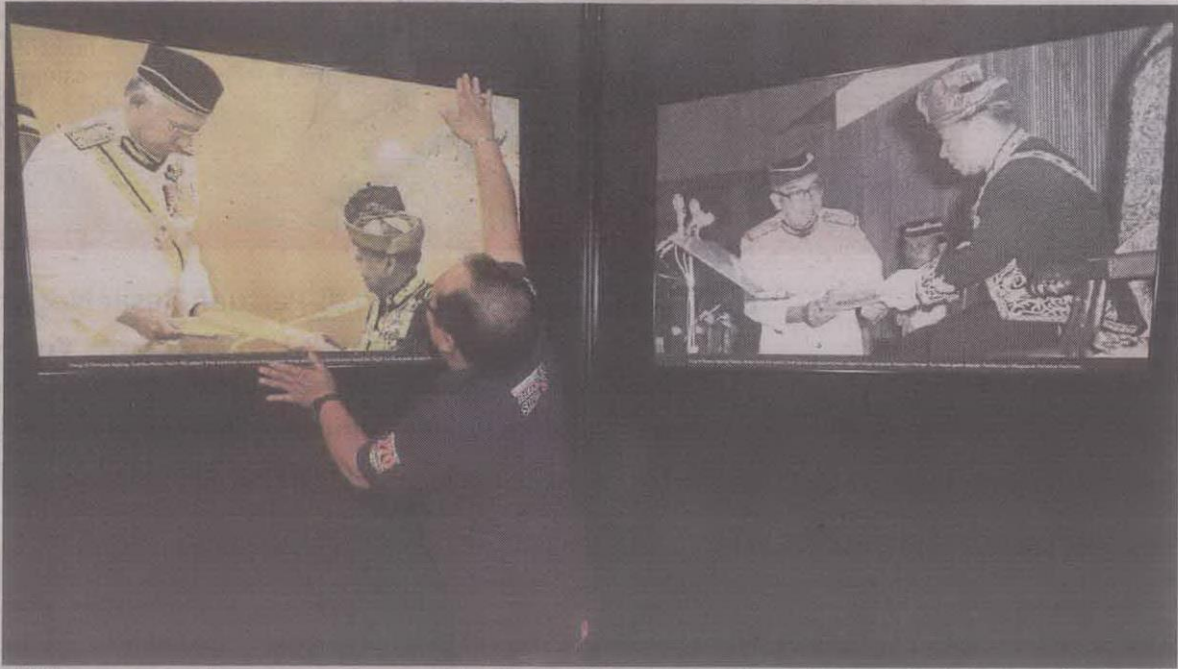
Some of the pictures are exclusive shots of the former prime minister with the people during his tenure,

which have never been printed.

Ramlan said visitors to the exhibition, which would be held from 9am to 5pm, could buy some of the pictures on display.

The seminar, organised by the Asian Strategy and Leadership Institute and Yayasan Cemerlang, commemorates the 40th anniversary of Tun Razak's death.

The exhibition aims at celebrating Tun Razak's life, as well as honouring his contributions to the country.
