PM donates RM20,000 to school gutted by fire

DENGKIL: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak has contributed RM20,000 to Madrasah Tahfiz Al-Redzuan here, which was gutted by fire last Monday.

The contribution was handed over by Selangor Umno liaison chief Datuk Seri Noh Omar, on behalf of the prime minister, to the religious school head Ishak Jamil, when Noh visited the school in Kampung Dato Ahmad Razali yesterday.

Noh said the aid would be used to upgrade the community hall located in front of the school, which would be used as temporary accommodation for 30 students.

The fire broke out at 8.15pm and destroyed the two-storey building, which housed the hostel and dining hall.

The students were given a week's break following the blaze.
