# Najib's site lists 40 years of feats

**TRACK RECORD:** Revamped official website details his political achievements over the decades

PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak has shared his 40 years of achievements as a politician on his official website, which has been given a facelift.

Among the things highlighted under the "Track Record" section on [www.najibrazak.com](http://www.najibrazak.com) is the im-

provement to the national education policy that was implemented when Najib was education minister in 1995, which he highlighted in a Facebook post.

"I was given the responsibility of being education minister from 1995 to 1999.

"During that time, I introduced changes to strengthen the education system, including formulating the Education Act 1996," he said in the

post, which was accompanied by a picture of him taken from the New Straits Times Press News and Image Bank.

The entries include links to websites carrying compilations of Najib's achievements and important events throughout his involvement in the government and politics since 1976.

The interactive page describes the beginning of his political career as

the youngest member of parliament, when he won the Pahang seat of Pekan unopposed in 1976.

Other achievements and events are also displayed, with some accompanied by photos.

Ten-year summaries of Najib's achievements can be viewed under the "Track Record" section.

The website features measures undertaken by Najib, in his capacity as finance minister, to cushion the

impact of the global economic downturn, as well as his achievements as prime minister.

Additionally, there are videos that illustrate his accomplishments.

In 2008, Najib's first video was uploaded on YouTube.

It shows him as the then acting finance minister at a press conference after a briefing with Bank Negara and local financial institutions.
