## Siti Nuraisyah meets PM

**SUNGAI BESAR:** It was a heartwarming event at Masjid Al-Mu'min in Parit 12 in Sungai Nibong here last night when Siti Nuraisyah Sahrin, 13, who lost her legs in an accident in January, got her wish to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

The Form One student of SM Bagan Terap in Sungai Panjang met Najib at the mosque's compound after tarawih prayers.

Najib, who is also Barisan Nasional chairman, spent five minutes with her, asked how she was doing and advised her to excel in her studies.

He was accompanied by Selangor BN chairman Tan Sri Noh Omar and BN candidate for Sungai Besar Budiman Mohd Zohdi.

Siti Nuraisyah, the fourth of seven

siblings, said Najib also asked about her hobbies, and upon finding out that she was interested to learn to play musical instruments, promised to give her a drum set.

She said she had wanted to meet Najib to thank him for his concern.

Najib had given her RM10,000 in aid early this year.

"Finally, I get to meet the prime minister.

"I'm really touched by his kindness," she said.

Earlier, Najib and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, performed tarawih prayers with 300 villagers.

Siti Nuraisyah, from Parit 16 in Sungai Panjang, fell from a motorcycle while riding pillion with her stepsister near their house on Jan 18.

A lorry then ran over her legs, which had to be amputated.

She received the financial aid when Umno Welfare Bureau chair-

man Datuk Seri Abdul Azeez Abdul Rahim visited her on behalf of Najib at Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital in Klang on Jan 20.
