Hadi says he met Dr M over plan to topple Najib

SUNGAI BESAR: Pas president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang admitted that former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad met him three months ago to discuss a plan to topple Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

Hadi, however, said he rejected the offer as it would not be beneficial to him or the party.

“Pas does not oppose any individual. It opposes only weak concepts and policies. If a person changes his behaviour but the policy and approach are the same, nothing changes. Also, if an approach and

behaviour remain unchanged, nothing is going to change,” he said during a walkabout at the Ramadan bazaar in Sekinchan here yesterday.

On the suggestion of former chief justice of Malaya Tun Abdul Hamid Mohamad that Umno and Pas join forces to strengthen the position of Malays and Islam, Hadi said: “We have guidelines in the Quran. We need to go back to the Quran before we can be united.”

During the walkabout, Pas offered the public free health checks and replacement of motorcycle engine oil. **Bernamea**
