'I do not want my name used'

ALOR STAR: Persatuan Anak Muda Kedah, a non-governmental organisation, has urged the police to investigate the validity of the signatures contained in the Mahathir-Kit Siang declaration.

Its chairman, Saiful Zamani Ahmad, said he wanted police to probe whether his or his wife's names, along with the names of the association's members, had been used in the declaration without their consent.

"This is important as I do not want other quarters to misuse my name, or my wife's name.

"Tun Dr Mahathir (Mohamad) himself had admitted to the existence of more than 300,000 fake names (in the declaration), but there are other parties who claim that more than 900,000 names are fake.

"I would like to stress that I do not support this declaration in any manner," he said here yesterday.

Saiful said that members of his association had also complained to him, expressing their concern and asking if their names had been included among the signatories.

He said that as chairman, he was representing them in matters that could spoil the good name of youths and Dr Mahathir himself for bringing something that was not true to the attention of the Yang diPertuan Agong.

Saiful was met at the Kota Star District police headquarters here yesterday, where he had filed a report urging the police to investigate and scrutinise the validity of the signatures provided in the declaration.
