CARING: Medical treatment for three with heart disease

PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak yesterday presented aid from the Global Children's Wellbeing Fund (GCWF) to help sick children with their medical treatment.

Three of these children — 4-month-old Nur Sumayyah Abdullah; Muhammad Ammar Che Mohd Asri, 5; and Nisa Syakirah Annailah Muhamad Sairi, 2 — are listed under the Media Prima-NSTP Humanitarian Fund.

The three of them suffer from congenital heart disease and will need to undergo surgeries.
