Mahathir: I will not join Opposition *The Sun - 2/3/2016*

PETALING JAYA: Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad has rejected the idea of joining the Opposition front following his exit from Umno on Monday, citing differences in views.

He said Umno was the only political party he would consider joining but only if party president Datuk Seri Najib Abdul

Razak quits.

The country's fourth and longest serving prime minister had also quit Umno during the tenure of Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, but later rejoined the party when Najib became party president and prime minister.

Speaking to the media yesterday at the Proton Centre of Excellence, Mahathir said he did not subscribe to the Opposition's views and struggles, adding

that he only subscribed to the struggles of Umno.

When asked about his plans, he said he would continue to expose the wrongdoings of the present government.

On *The Wall Street Journal's* latest report, he said Najib should sue the publication for false reporting if there was no truth to the allegations.

"They can be sued in their own country. He can sue," he said.
