Najib officiates new Malaysian High Commission complex in India

NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak last night officiated the new Malaysian High Commission complex in India.

Najib signed a plaque to officiate the complex after a ribbon-cutting ceremony before being given a briefing on the complex.

Najib was accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor.

Also present were Transport Minister Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai, Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr S. Subramaniam, Works Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof, Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Reezal Merican Naina Merican, Foreign Ministry secretary-general Datuk Ramlan Ibrahim, High Commissioner to India Datuk Hidayat Abdul Hamid and Special Envoy of Infrastructure to India and Southern Asia Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu.

Work on the complex started in 2013 and was completed in June 2015, costing RM121 million.

Four blocks sit on a 2.2ha site; namely the High Commissioner's residence, a multipurpose hall, the chancery building and staff housing complex.
