Azmin telling a lie unless he can prove it, says Najib

PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak said no ministers in his cabinet are resigning.

He said the tweet by PKR deputy president and Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azmin Ali was a lie unless he could prove it.

“No minister has informed me that he is quitting. I shall assume Azmin is telling a lie to create a stir unless he can reveal the name,”

Najib tweeted last night.

He was responding to an earlier tweet by Azmin, who claimed he had heard that a senior minister had left the cabinet following issues relating to IMalaysia Development Bhd (IMDB).

“*Benarkah ada seorang Menteri Kanan telah meletakkan jawatan? Khabarnya beliau tidak mahu bersubahat dengan IMDB. Cuba ikuti perkembangan.*” (Is it true, that a senior minister had quit? Word has it that the person does not want to be in cahoots with IMDB. Let’s follow

the development).

Following the tweet, rumours were rife that Datuk Seri Anifah Aman was the minister mentioned.

However, an aide to the foreign minister, when contacted last night, denied Anifah is resigning.

“As far as I know, it is not true. I have not heard anything. Plus, he is attending two official functions tomorrow.

“Anifah is in Kota Kinabalu right now attending a function,” the aide said.

Another aide also denied the rumours.
